We are looking for candidates who have a strong passion for pioneering and developing state-of-the-art areas, and who possess deep experience and a proven track record in this field.

Responsibilities will include teaching at both the undergraduate and graduate levels, and directing research projects, which will lead to MS and Ph. D. theses. The applicants must hold a doctoral degree in an appropriate field. Profound knowledge of the Japanese or English language, written and spoken, is also required. The position is open to any candidate who fulfills the listed academic requirements, regardless of gender or nationality. The successful applicant, of Japanese or non-Japanese nationality, will become a Japanese National University Corporation employee and will be paid accordingly.

Applications will be reviewed until the position is filled; all applications received by 1/31/2024 will be considered. The position is available as early as 10/1/2024.
